Dear Partners,

In preparation for the next SYMPOSIUM Meeting which takes place in Dublin on the 13th and 14th May 2019 please see the following details for travel and accommodation in this email.

**Meeting venue:** St. Patrick's campus and All Hallows Campus of Dublin City University which are both located in the centre of Drumcondra. ([click here for Google Maps location](#)).

**Accommodation:**

**Option 1:** our recommendation and first choice is Dublin Skylon Hotel ([hotel info here](#)) located next door to the meeting venue. A special rate was agreed with Skylon for the meeting, they are holding a maximum of 20 rooms at discounted rates below from the 12th to the 16th May as follows: See the email which we received from the hotel copied below:

I can hold the rooms on option for you until April the 1st after which time I will need exact confirmation as we have limited availability on those particular dates.

Each reservation will have to be confirmed with a credit card. Cancellation policy is 72 hours prior to arrival. Cancellations made within 72 hours of arrival will incur a cancellation fee equivalent with the rate for the first night.

We will be in touch regarding some local information at a later date, but we do suggest that partners book this accommodation as soon as possible.

**Option 2:** While the rates at Dublin Skylon Hotel are very competitive for Dublin, there is also an option to stay in the Bonnington Hotel which is also located close to our campus and is accessible by walking to the campus. The rates per night are 100 euro per room which includes bed and breakfast.

from Sunday 12th May until Thursday 16th May 2019 for accommodation in this hotel. These are special corporate rates which can only be obtained by emailing the Bonnington Hotel [info@bonnington.com](mailto:info@bonnington.com) . Alternatively you can ring the hotel at + 353 1 8373544. Each reservation will have to be confirmed with a credit card.

**Option 3:** In Dublin centre you can find hostel accommodation in the city centre ie Isaacs Hostel, Generator Dublin,, Abigails Hostel. However they do tend to get booked out very quickly and I am not sure of availability of any of these hostels at the moment for these dates.

**Option 4:** Alternatively there are Bed and Breakfasts in the Drumcondra Area ie Errigal Guest House (approx 383 euro for four nights) , Kennedy's B+B Drumcondra (approx.. 600 euro for four nights), Aisling House Serviced Accommodation (456 euro for four nights). All of these are available through Booking.Com.

I checked the prices for four nights but of course many of our participants might only stay three nights so this will be cheaper again.

There are also Air B N B's in the Drumcondra area. These can be accessed through the Air B n B website.

***Just to remind you that the city centre is very close to Drumcondra but I would advise that members would try to book accommodation in the Drumcondra area for ease of access to the meetings.***

#### **Travel arrangements:**

Please note that all flights to Dublin airport for these dates are very close to our meeting location. The main airline carriers are Aer Lingus and Ryanair.

There are buses available to take participants from the airport to Drumcondra and these buses stop very close to the two hotels which are listed in this email. The average bus fare is approx.. 3 euro per single trip.

The university is located very close to the city centre. In fact it is within walking Please note that while we have three campus, the main campus where our meetings will take place is All Hallows Campus located in Drumcondra.
